

ELECTION DAY IS APRIL 7TH, 2020 WE ARE TAKING COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS SERIOUSLY

The City of Cudahy Clerk/Treasurer's Office is recommending that anyone concerned about the COVID-19 Virus consider an alternate means to cast a ballot that can minimize direct contact with other people and reduce crowd size at polling locations.

- You may cast your ballot via absentee by mail. Registered voters can obtain an absentee ballot via mail through https://myvote.wi.gov/en-us/ or at the Clerk's Office before 5pm on April 2, 2020.
- You may cast your ballot via In-Person Absentee in the Clerk's Office beginning March 23 on weekdays between 7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. on Friday, April 3, 2020. No absentee voting may be conducted on Monday, April 6, 2020.
- If you are planning to vote in-person on Election Day, try to arrive at off-peak times.
- You may bring your own black or blue **ball point pen** to complete your ballot. Be sure the ink will not run or the machine may not be able to read your ballot.
