



CUDAHY POLICE DEPARTMENT AUXILIARY POLICE OFFICER

The Cudahy Police Department (CUPD) is currently recruiting new volunteer Auxiliary Police Officers. CUPD is looking for individuals who want to serve the community in a volunteer capacity. This is an unpaid position and you will not be a sworn police officer. CUPD will provide training to qualified applicants and will establish a minimum amount of volunteer hours from each Auxiliary Officer. You must be able to pass a background check. If you have a documented criminal or alcohol related history, or undocumented history in the before mentioned areas discovered during a background investigation, this could be a disqualifier. You must be 21 years old to apply. Exception, you may apply at 18-20 years old if you are currently pursuing a law enforcement related college degree. Being an Auxiliary Officer with CUPD will not guarantee you an employment position with the City of Cudahy. This is a chance to get some hands-on experience in law enforcement and community service. If you are seriously pursuing a career in law enforcement; volunteer service is a resume builder for a potential candidate. We are also looking for military veterans who want to continue public service on a volunteer basis. Law enforcement retirees who have the time to volunteer and serve the community are encouraged to apply.
