Dead Bird Reporting Hotline Is Now Open

The **Dead Bird Reporting Hotline (1-800-433-1610)** has been activated and will remain open through the mosquito season until October 31, 2017. Just like previous years, the Dead Bird Reporting Hotline is available for Wisconsin residents to report sick or dead birds, and to facilitate West Nile virus (WNV) testing of corvids (crows, ravens, blue jays) to monitor WNV activity.

This document is designed for local and tribal public health departments and other public health partner agencies, and provides guidance on all human and non-human (bird, equine, mosquito) arbovirus surveillance activities in the state.
