

Like all Cudahy residents and residents of the south shore, the City of Cudahy was disappointed to learn of the closing of the Cudahy Pick N Save. The City received no prior notification from the new ownership, Kroger. The management and employees of the Cudahy Pick N Save have always treated customers with excellent customer service and respect. The Cudahy Pick N Save has also been very generous in supporting community causes and fund raising efforts in our community.

“I was saddened to learn the truth to the rumor yesterday”, stated Cudahy Mayor John Hohenfeldt. “I would ask any and all of the County and State Agencies to assist the employees displaced by this closing.” The closing of this store according to Kroger officials was due to underperformance and an oversaturation of stores in our market. The changing of consumer practices facing all retailers with on line shopping, including groceries, also probably played into the underperformance at this location.

The City will work with the property owners to attempt to attract hopefully another grocery store for this location. As always, the City of Cudahy asks all of our Cudahy and south shore residents to please support all of our local businesses.
